From the Board Meeting on May 11th.....

President Larry called a special board meeting to discuss the new Club Web Site – www.lmlions.org. Lion Scott Stone discussed in detail various particulars for the new club website. Calendar events need a description, date, and beginning & ending times, location and contact with phone and/or e-mail address. QIS, in Manchester has donated and is hosting the site. QIS also purchased domain for 1 year, which is due to expire. Lion Scott will communicate with QIS regarding a possible continuation. QIS is also donating the ability to have e-mail on site through website for lion members. There was a discussion on control, standards, management and guidelines for the website.
