# For the Good of Lionism! DISTRICT 22W GOVERNOR'S COMMENDATION

The District Governor's Commendation certificate and medal will be awarded by the District Governor to both clubs or individuals (both Lions, Lionesses, LEO's and non-Lions) who have demonstrated performance above and beyond what is normally expected during the operation of the club, a club project or a special event or occurrence. The award when presented to individuals will be in the form of both a certificate and the Governor's Commendation medal. Awards made to a club will be in certificate form only. Nominations for this award will be made, in writing, either by letter or e-mail directly to the District Governor stating the name of the club or individual nominated for the award and will include the date (s) and location of the event, project or occurrence and a short description of why the nominator believes a District Governor's Commendation will rest solely with the District Governor. Presentation of this award will be made by the District Governor or an individual designated by the District Governor at an appropriate meeting or ceremony.

I am urging all members to simply "ask" someone to become a Lion. Unless we ask, we will never have new Lions. I am in the process of working with Second Vice District Governor Steve Finger and PDG John Hopkins to arrange for a New Member Orientation session sometime after January 1, 2010. *Lion Robert C. #### **Convention Notes**


