WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING

There were 12 members present at the **March 3rd** meeting held at the North Carroll Senior Center in Greenmount. Mrs. Tammy Black from Access Carroll Pathway to Health made an excellent presentation. She discussed how her organization provides primary health care to uninsured, low-income Carroll County residents. Founded in 2005, Access Carroll, Inc. is a non-profit organization, offering free health care to residents who meet certain eligibility requirements. Primary medical care is provided by volunteer physicians, nurses and other experienced medical professionals. By

removing traditional barriers to quality health care, Access Carroll strives to help patients maintain good health and learn to manage any acute or chronic illnesses. Access Carroll is funded by grants and donations from individuals and local businesses and organizations. Access Carroll is located in downtown Westminster, at the corner of Locust and Winters Street. They can be reached at (410) 871-1478. President Charlie presented Mrs. Black with a \$50 donation from the club.

A second presentation was made by Mr. Tom McElroy from the U.S. Census Bureau who spoke about the need for Census Takers in Carroll County.

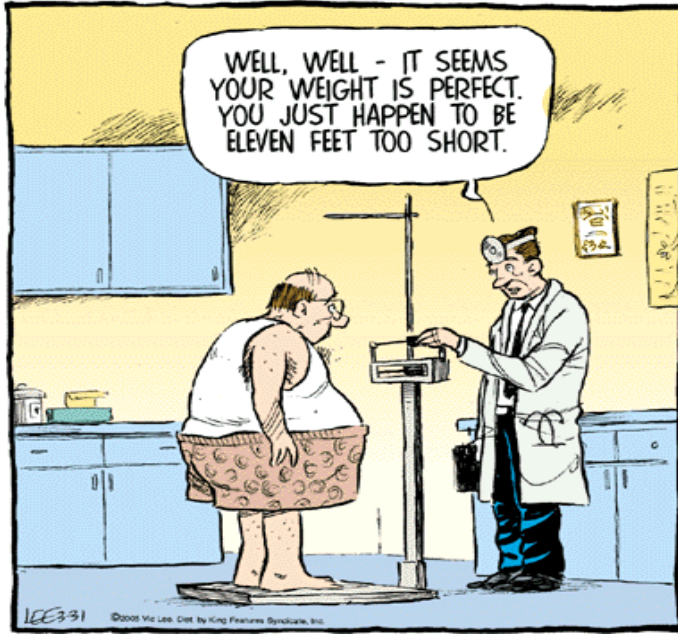

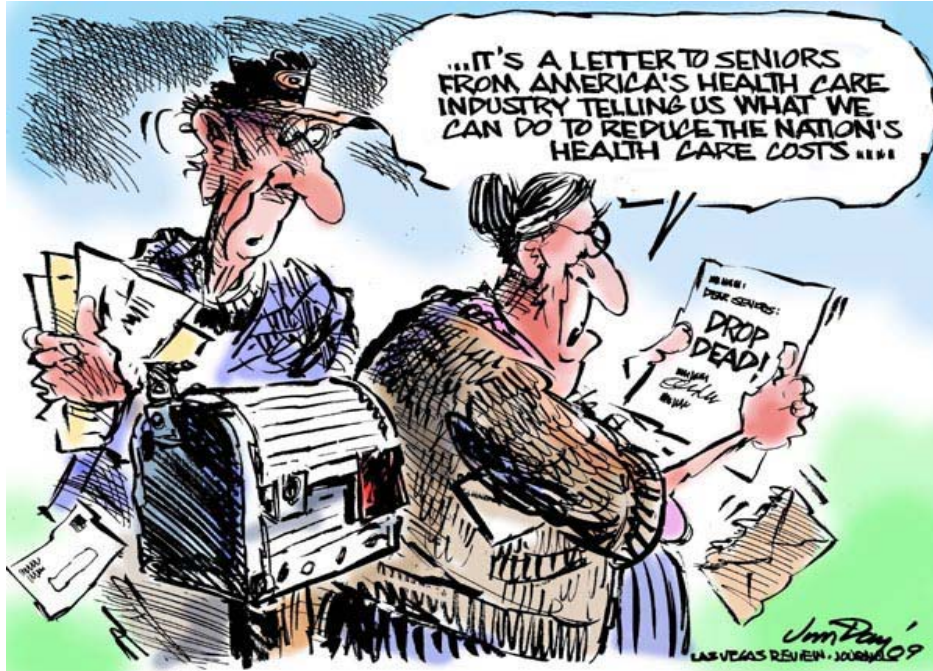
