From our Board Meeting, July 14, 2010

There were 9 members present at the meeting held at the North Carroll Senior Center in Greenmount.

Secretary Christy reported that there was a request from the American Red Cross for our Lions Club to sponsor a blood drive. Lion Joe volunteered to Chair this event. There are plans to hold it in October.

Treasurer Andy reported that a donation of \$50.00 was made in memory of Ada Snyder, mother of Lion Anna Welch and mother-in law of Lion Carl Welsh.

There was a suggestion to do a "practice audit" on the club's books and that it is done once a year. There was a request to publish the donations and amounts made to organizations.

Pool – Lion Joe reported that the pool is having a banner year. Good weather, good concession sales and allowing families to pay their memberships in payments have helped make it a good season.

Wooden nickels have been purchased as incentives for the Swim Club. When swimmers' times improve, they get wooden nickels to redeem at the concession stand.
