From the Desk of Steve Swam

At their recent Charter Night, the Lineboro-Manchester Lions Club presented their **Annual Citizenship Award** to Mrs. Mary Shunk. This award is presented to an individual who displays extraordinary volunteerism in the North Carroll community. This award comes with a gift certificate for dinner at a local restaurant and a \$200 donation to the charity of the recipient's choice. Mary has been an active member of her community her whole life and never tires of helping others. She has been providing an invaluable experience for disabled riders in Maryland for over thirty years. As a 4-H leader, 4-H Therapeutic Riding Program volunteer instructor, riding instructor, mentor and friend to many, human and equine alike, Mary's influence is widespread and magical! Mary helped bring Equestrian Sports to Maryland Special Olympics in 1987, and has been one of the games organizers ever since. She has served as the Maryland Team Coach for four different World Games. She organized a second day of competition at the Maryland Special Olympics Summer Games to provide a competition venue for riders with disabilities that do not qualify for Special Olympics. One of her students says: "Mary Shunk is a godsend. Due to her teaching and support, not only have I regained many of my lost riding skills, but after two brain injuries, a knee replacement and a ruptured quad ligament, I've gotten back an integral part of my identity." "My muscles are stronger, I have increased balance, stamina and self-esteem, and she has helped me to remember that there is always hope." "Ms. Mary changes the lives of everyone she comes in contact with: horse, rider, volunteer, observer." "I can't say enough to convey how important she has been/is to me."

It is with great pleasure and pride, that the members of the Lineboro-Manchester Lions Club present this **Citizenship Award** to Mrs. Mary Shunk.
